**DRIVEWAY PERMIT**

Subject to all terms, conditions and restrictions printed or written below, and attached hereof, permission is hereby granted to

Permission is granted to install a driveway at the above location contingent on the following:

The entire area of the driveway approach within the town way shall be excavated to a minimum of 15" prior to the placement of bank run and/or crushed gravel as required by town specifications. The entire area of the driveway within the town way shall be paved with bituminous concrete. The driveway shall not extend on to the traveled way and the existing gutter line shall not be disturbed.

The grantee shall notify the Public Works Department as far in advance as possible so an inspection can be made during the construction process.

The driveway shall be constructed according to town specifications contained herein.

The holder of this permit is obligated to pay all expenses in conjunction with this permit.

Drainage patterns shall not be altered.

The paved approach shall extend a minimum of 15 feet from the road edge toward the abutting lot.

Width of the driveway opening is at the discretion of the Public Works Department.

Suggested side yard set back is 15 feet.

No work shall be done under this permit until the Grantee has communicated with and received instructions from the Public Works Department. A minimum notice of 48 hours shall be given to the Public Works Department before any work is begun. This permit shall be void unless the work herein contemplated is completed within 30 days or an extension can be granted at the discretion of the Public Works Department.

During the progress of the work all structures under ground and above ground shall be properly protected from damage or injury; such barriers shall be erected and maintained as may be necessary for the protection of the traveling public; the same shall be properly lighted at night; and the Grantee shall be responsible for all damages to persons or property due to or resulting from any work done under this permit.

If the Grantee does any work contrary to the orders of the Public Works Department, and after due notice, fails to correct such work or remove structures or materials ordered to be removed or fails to complete the work authorized by this permit, the department may, with or without notice, correct or complete such work in whole or in part, or remove such structures or materials, and the Grantee shall reimburse the Town for any expenses incurred in correcting and/or completing the work or removing the structures or materials.

On the completion of the work herein contemplated all rubbish and debris shall be removed and the roadway and roadsides shall be left neat and presentable and satisfactory to the Public Works Department.

All of the above conditions shall be applicable to the work herein authorized, unless the same are inconsistent with the conditions on the face of the permit, in which case the conditions written or printed on the face of the permit shall apply.

The acceptance of this permit or the doing of any work there under shall constitute an agreement by the Grantee to comply with all for the conditions and restrictions printed or written herein.

Your attention is called to Section 40 of Chapter 82 of the General Laws of Massachusetts requiring 48 hours notice be given in writing of proposed excavations to all utilities. In the event of an emergency, notice shall be given as soon as possible.
