GREETING:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Montague qualified to vote in Town affairs to meet in the Turners Falls High School Theater on Saturday, May 3, 2008, at 8:30 A.M. and to act on the following articles and any motions which may be presented.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the town will vote to appropriate the sum of \$21,043.50, or any other amount, for the purpose of funding a deficit in the FY 2008 snow and ice budget, or pass any vote or votes in relation thereto.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the town will vote to appropriate the sum of \$200, or any other amount, for the purpose of funding a prior year (FY 2006) bill to the Guilford Transportation Industries Inc., or to pass any vote or votes in relation thereto.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to spend funds appropriated under Article 5 of the October 11, 2007 Special Town Meeting (Strathmore Paper Mill Building Stabilization), for legal expenses incurred in the implementation of this project and for any operations and maintenance costs incurred in FY 2009, or pass any vote or votes in relation thereto.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof in some conspicuous place in each of the Post Offices, Libraries, and Town Hall of the Town, at least fourteen days before said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this document with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk fourteen days before said meeting.
