

**SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

To either of the Constables of the Town of Montague in the County of Franklin:

GREETING:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Montague qualified to vote in Town affairs to meet in the Turners Falls High School Theater on Wednesday, February 18, 2015 at 6:30 P.M. and to act on the following articles and any motions which may be presented.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide the sum of \$10,078, or any other amount, for the purpose of supplementing Article #9 of the September 12, 2013 Special Town Meeting, which funded costs associated with the implementation of a collective bargaining agreement with the United Electrical, Radio and Machine Workers of America, Local 274 for Fiscal Year 2014, with increases to be paid retroactively to July 1, 2013, or to pass any vote or votes in relation thereto.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide the sum of \$15,000, or any other amount, for the purpose of supplementing the Fiscal Year 2015 Police Department Budget, or to pass any vote or votes in relation thereto.

(Police Department Request)

ARTICLE 3. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide the sum of \$22,500, or any other amount, for the purpose of supplementing the Fiscal Year 2015 Legal Budget, or to pass any vote or votes in relation thereto.

(Board of Selectmen Request)

ARTICLE 4. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide the sum of \$40,000, or any other amount, for the purpose of purchasing a sander and plow and for other expenses for setting up and equipping a new 6 wheel dump truck being purchased with Chapter 90 funds or to pass any vote or votes in relation thereto.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen, acting as Sewer Commissioners, to acquire by purchase, gift, eminent domain or otherwise, a permanent easement in the following described property and to accept a deed or deeds on such terms and conditions as the Board of Selectmen deems appropriate, in, along, upon and under a parcel of land containing 2,310 square feet, more or less, situated on First Street, and shown as parcel "E-2" on a plan entitled "Proposed Easement to be granted to the Town of Montague by FirstLight Hydro Generating Company First Street Montague, MA," dated January 15, 2015, which plan is on file with the office of the Town Clerk, for the purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining the new First Street Sanitary Sewage Pump Station, or to pass any vote or votes in relation thereto.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen, acting as Sewer Commissioners, to acquire by purchase, gift, eminent domain or otherwise, a permanent easement in the following described property and to accept a deed or deeds on such terms and conditions as the Board of Selectmen deems appropriate, in, along, upon and under a parcel of land containing 332 square feet, more or less, situated on the southerly side of Poplar Street, and shown as parcel "E-1" on a plan entitled "Proposed Easement to be granted to the Town of Montague by FirstLight Hydro Generating Company Poplar Street Montague, MA," dated January 15, 2015, which plan is on file with the office of the Town Clerk, for the purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining the new Poplar Street Sanitary Sewage Pump Station, or to pass any vote or votes in relation thereto.

(WPCF Request)

ARTICLE 7. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to acquire by purchase, gift, eminent domain or otherwise, for general municipal purposes all or a portion of the following described property on such terms and conditions as the Board of Selectmen deems appropriate and to accept the deed of a fee simple interest in the land containing .189 acres, more or less, and the building and parking thereon, located at 62 Fifth Street in the Town of Montague and shown on Assessors Map 4, Lot 266, and to enter into all agreements and execute all instruments as may be necessary on behalf of the Town to effect said acquisition; and to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide the sum of \$1.00 or any other amount to effect said acquisition, or to pass any vote or votes in relation thereto.

(Board of Selectmen Request)

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof in some conspicuous place in each of the Post Offices, Libraries, and Town Hall of the Town, at least fourteen days before said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this document with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk fourteen days before said meeting.
