McDonald is hoping to evaluate how to increase the facility as far as composting goes. We are focusing on reducing the amount of solids that come into our plant.

• Solar Project Update

The engineering design is being completed. There is an RFP draft, which will be looked over by McDonald and Ellis. McDonald wants to explore whether it would be possible for an existing facility to apply for another Smart Program, should one come up in a couple of years.
